

## Sample Course Map: 3 Year BBA- General

This is a sample course schedule. You will require 90 credit hours for this degree. 36 of those hours must be BUS courses. Please note when selecting elective credits that you can use a maximum of 42 credit hours at the 1000 level. Semester long courses are 3 credit hours and year-long courses are 6 credit hours.

- **This sample course map is intended as an example to give students an idea of what a typical programme may look like.**
- Students should review this map **but not rely on it for planning**. The UW Calendar provides the [degree requirements](#).
- Make an appointment with [Student Planning](#) to ensure you are choosing the right courses.
- Note that there are some anomalies in [WEBADVISOR](#) so it is important to consult the UW Calendar and Student Planning if the programme information is not clear.
- Students can also consult specific [BUS ADMIN requirements](#) for course information and prerequisites.
- Students are not required to take 5 courses each term. It is also possible to take a limited number of courses during the Spring term.
